Scope of Responsibilities

The responsibilities for this role include, but are not limited to the following:

- Sample and ship water and receiving environment surface and ground water,
- Inspect, install and ensure proper operation of water management structures, including diversion ditches, collection ponds and sumps,
- Work closely with the Ulkatcho First Nation, Lhoosk'uz Dené Nation Environmental Monitors to assess environmental protection measures for the project

- Complete flow measurements at surface water sites and maintain the calibration requirements,
